

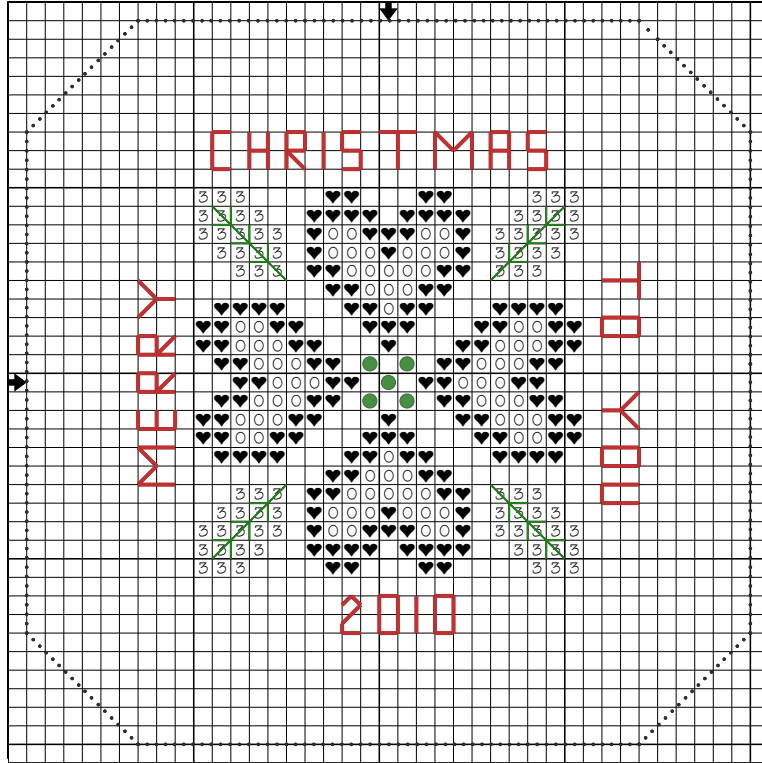

Counted Cross Stitch Designs

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Stitches: 39 stitches wide by 39 stitches high

Stitched Area:

- 10 count: 4 inches wide by 4 inches high
- 14 count: 2 3/4 in. wide by 2 3/4 in. high
- 18 count: 2 1/4 in. wide by 2 1/4 in. high
- 28 count: 1 1/2 in. wide by 1 1/2 in. high

* The dotted black line indicates where you would put the backstitching for sewing the piece to its back. Use the exact same dimensions from the front/stitched side for the piece of fabric for the back of the ornament. In this case, the same fabric was used for both sides so it was easy to backstitch the exact number and size of stitches for both sides (pieces of fabric). Use a whipped stitch to sew the two pieces together, right sides out. Use one bead per stitch of the whipped stitch. The beads are sewn so they alternate between the Oriental Red and the Brilliant Shamrock beads.

Model was stitched using DMC floss, Mill Hill beads from Wichelt Imports, Inc. "over 2" on 28 count Lugana "White" (#3270-100) from Needleworker's Delight/Zweigart.

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
